

## **2008 Information**

**Energy Lake Campground at Land Between The Lakes located on beautiful Energy Lake near Lake Barkley is open March 1 through November 30.**

**ENERGY LAKE CAMPGROUND** offers 48 well-defined sites; 35 with electrical hookups capable of handling tents or motor homes. Energy offers a swimming and beach area, playground, activity field, canoe and kayak rentals, and hiking trails.

### **PLEASE READ THESE IMPORTANT GUIDELINES**

During your stay with us, please help provide a quality experience for all our visitors.

1. Select campsites are available on a first-come, first-served basis or by reservation. For reservations, please refer to "Reservations" section. For first-come, first-served sites, at least one person 18 years of age or older and a proper camping unit must occupy the site the first night. After the first night, the camping unit may not be left unattended for more than a 24 hour period without permission. Camping unit must occupy site immediately after registration.
2. Do not change sites without checking with gatehouse staff.
3. Visitation for registered campers is between 7 a.m. and 11 p.m. A \$5 visitor fee per vehicle is charged. (After 11 p.m. a full camping fee is charged.)
4. All camping units and equipment must be placed on the prepared gravel sites unless the camping unit requires stakes for use. The camping unit then must be placed within 15 feet of the pad. Refer to "Our Fees" for regulations.
6. Quiet hours are observed between 11 p.m. and 7 a.m. Please return to your site during quiet hours as a courtesy to others.
7. Use of generators is not permitted during quiet hours.
8. Metal detectors are prohibited in LBL.
9. Check-out time is 3:30 p.m. Late departures are prohibited. A \$16 late fee will be added for late departures.
10. Camping is limited to 21 consecutive days on any site. After 21 days, the camping unit must be moved from the site for a minimum of seven days before returning to the previously occupied site.
11. Displaying sale signs, attempting to sell goods or services, advertising such services, or distribution of written material without a Forest Service permit is prohibited.
12. Shelter buildings are shared with all campers, unless group reservations occupy one-half of the loop.

### **OUR FEES**

Each campsite is limited to two camping units --one adult and one child. A camping unit is any object used for sleeping in (RV, pop-up, tent, car, screen house, tarp, etc.). A child's tent (2 to 3 person) will be allowed free of charge with each paid camping unit as long as only children 17 years of age and under occupy it. All vehicles, including cars, vans, boats, jet skis, or utility trailers, must park on the graveled area when available. Overflow parking is available at all shower buildings and parking lots. Do not park along roads or on grass where signs are posted. Citations will be written and/or vehicles towed at owners expense.

A camping fee is charged for each camping unit. Each camping fee allows for two vehicles. Extra vehicles and visitors will be charged a fee.

## **SERVICES**

Ice, firewood, and tick repellent are available for purchase at the gatehouse.

Soft drink machines are located at the gatehouse. Washers and dryers are available in the assembly building.

## **FOR YOUR SAFETY**

1. Pets must be on a leash of 6 ft. or less and under physical control at all times.
2. For health and sanitation purposes, you are required to clean up after your pet.
3. Campers under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
4. Immediately report any theft, loss, accident, or disturbance to the staff or call 911.
5. Fireworks are prohibited at all times.
6. Firearms are prohibited, except during LBL hunting seasons by licensed and permitted hunters.
7. Archery target practice is prohibited.
8. All campfires must be contained in designated fire rings. Please extinguish all campfires thoroughly before vacating the site.
9. The designated swimming and beach area is open during daylight hours. Beach is available for use by registered campers only and is dependent on lake conditions.
10. Pets and glass containers are not permitted on the beach, in swimming areas, bathrooms, or shower buildings.
11. State law prohibits public consumption of alcoholic beverages.
12. Cooking with an open flame in the shower buildings and shelter buildings is prohibited.
13. Electric grills and stoves may be used in the shelter buildings.

## **RULES OF THE ROAD**

1. The speed limit is 15 mph and is enforced throughout the campground. Please be courteous, cautious, and drive slower in congested areas.
2. Golf carts may serve as an additional means of transportation for individuals displaying an official state issued accessible window tag or license plate. Only the individual issued the tag is permitted to operate the golf cart, unless a physical impairment does not allow.
3. Motorcycles must be properly licensed and used only on roads designated for motorized vehicles. All motorized vehicles need to be licensed and have a licensed driver.
4. Moped operators must be 16 years of age and possess a valid drivers license. Safety helmets are recommended. mopeds are not permitted on walking or biking trails. All state laws are enforced.
5. All-terrain vehicles (ATVs) are prohibited. They may not be unloaded in camping area. Please visit Turkey Bay Off-Highway Vehicle (OHV) Area for riding.
6. All of Energy Lake is a "No Wake Zone".
7. After quiet hours, please limit vehicle traffic to entering and exiting the campground.

## **OUR ENVIRONMENT NEEDS YOUR HELP**

*LBL is working toward a cleaner, healthier environment.*

1. State law prohibits discharge of gray or black water. Please use Central or North Dump Stations. Citations will be written.
2. Vehicle maintenance is prohibited within the campground.
3. Do not clean fish or other game in shower building sinks or at water faucets/hydrants.
4. Do not wash dishes, brush teeth, or wash up at potable water sources.
5. For your safety, drinking water is treated and monitored by employees with state certification.
6. To protect the water supply from harmful bacteria, please do not leave water hoses attached to water hydrants when not in use. Hoses must be removed from hydrant areas.
7. Wastewater is processed on site through state permitted treatment facilities. Please help us to maintain the quality of treatment by using biodegradable detergents and antifreezes.
8. Do not nail, carve, or hang lanterns on trees. It will damage and destroy our natural resources.
9. Wildlife and plants are protected. Please do not feed the wildlife.

## **RESERVATIONS**

Reservations are available for select campsites at Energy Lake Campground. Reservations are also available at Wranglers, Piney, and Hillman Ferry Campgrounds.

1. Contact the National Recreation Reservation Service (NRRS) at 1-877-444-6777, TDD 1-877-833-6777, or online at [www.recreation.gov](http://www.recreation.gov) to make a reservation. (This information is valid through Sept. 30, 2008. After that date, call 270-924-2000 or visit [www.lbl.org](http://www.lbl.org).)
2. Reservations may be made up to six months in advance of arrival for select sites.
3. The NRRS charges non-refundable fees beyond our camping fees for making reservations, reservation changes, late cancellations, and no-shows.
4. All Campground policies and procedures apply to reservable sites.
5. Check-in time for reserved sites is 4:30 p.m. on date of arrival. Check-out time is 3:30 p.m. on departure date. Late departures are prohibited.
6. Calls not accepted Dec. 1-Feb. 28 while campground is closed.

## **KAYAK AND CANOE RENTALS . . .**

We offer kayak and canoe rentals to non-registered campers from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily. (Availability based on capacity, weather, and lake conditions.) Rentals are available for use on Energy Lake only. Paddles and life jackets are included.
