ABOUT HILLMAN FERRY CAMPGROUND

Hillman Ferry Campground offers 378 well-defined sites capable of handling a variety of camping from tents to large motor homes. Basic, electric, water, and sewer sites are available. In the spring and fall, water at sites will not be available due to colder temperatures (water will be available at designated hydrants). Campers have access to modern facilities, including a large swimming area, archery range, ball field, bike trails, campfire amphitheater, hiking trails, two boat launching ramps, picnic tables and fire rings. During the summer season we offer recreation programs for all ages. Hillman Ferry Outpost offers camping supplies and rental service.

CAMPSITE GUIDELINES

During your stay with us, please help provide a quality experience for all our visitors.

1. Select campsites are available on a first-come, first-served basis or by reservation. For reservations, please refer to the "Reservations" section. For first-come, first-served sites, at least one person 18 years of age or older and a proper camping unit must occupy the site the first night. After the first night, the camping unit may not be left unattended for more than a 24-hour period without permission. Camping unit must occupy site immediately after registration.
2. First-come, first-served campsites will be assigned upon registering at the gatehouse. If there is a specific campsite you would like, please inquire about availability and attendants will do their best to accommodate you. If you see another site you would prefer, return to gate-house to check availability, as we may have already assigned it. Every camper is allowed one site change after registration. After the first site change any additional site change, except for upgrades, could be subject to a \$5 fee per site, per change. We will gladly change your site if the site is available.
3. Do not change sites without checking with gate-house staff.
4. Visitation for registered campers is between 7 a.m. and 11 p.m. A \$5 visitor fee per vehicle is charged. (After 11 p.m. a full camping fee is charged.)
5. All camping units, equipment, and vehicles must be placed on prepared gravel sites. Refer to Campsite Capacity for regulations.
6. Quiet hours are observed between 11 p.m. and 7 a.m. Please return to campsite during quiet hours as a courtesy to others.
7. Use of generators is not permitted during quiet hours, except in the 24-hour Generator Area B36-B47.
8. Metal detectors are prohibited in LBL.
9. Check-out time is 3:30 p.m. Late departures are prohibited. A \$16 late fee will be added for late departures.
10. Camping is limited to 21 consecutive days on any site with the exception of our Seasonal Camping Program. After 21 days, campers and all equipment must move from the site for a minimum of 7 consecutive days prior to returning to the previously occupied site.
11. To properly occupy a site, all camping units must be fully set up. Tents must display a valid tent tag that is visible from the road.
12. Displaying sale signs, attempting to sell goods or services, advertising such services, or distributing written material without a Forest Service permit is prohibited.

CAMPSITE CAPACITY

Each paid campsite allows for two vehicles. Additional vehicles and visitors will be charged. Each campsite is limited to a maximum of eight people per site, five overnight vehicles, and two camping units, only one of which may be wheeled. When the number of persons wishing to occupy a site exceeds eight, a second site must be rented and occupied. Camping units are defined as follows: wheeled camping units (RV, pop-up, trailer, fifth wheel, truck camper, truck with topper) or tent. Tarps, awnings, dining canopies, screen tents, or vehicles other than those listed, may not solely occupy a campsite. Storage tents are not permitted.

EXAMPLES PERMITTED:

- A. Wheeled camping unit and one tent;
- B. Two tents.

EXAMPLES NOT PERMITTED:

- A. RV and trailer (two-wheeled camping units);
- B. Fifth wheel and pop-up;
- C. Three tents regardless of size.

All vehicles including cars, trucks, vans, and all trailers must park on prepared gravel pad. Overflow parking is available at all shower buildings and parking lots. Do not park along roads or on grass. Vehicles may not park on unoccupied sites. Citations will be written and/or vehicles towed at owners expense.

OUR FEES

A camping fee is charged for each camping unit. See Campsite Capacity for more information.

National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Access and Senior Passes and Golden Age and Access Passports honored for 50% off basic camping fees. Please see gatehouse attendant for refund policy. Water will not be available at sites in March and November.

OTHER SERVICES

Ice and firewood are available for purchase at the Outpost and Gatehouse. Soft drink machines are located at Snack Shack and Shower Building in Area A. Washers and dryers are available in Areas A, C, D, & T.

RESERVATIONS

Reservations are available for select campsites at Hillman Ferry Campground. Reservations are also available at Wranglers, Piney, and Energy Lake Campgrounds.

1. Contact the National Recreation Reservation Service (NRRS) at 1-877-444-6777, TDD 1-877-

833-6777, or online at www.recreation.gov to make a reservation. (This information is valid through Sept. 30, 2008. After that date, call 270-924-2000 or visit www.lbl.org.)

2. Reservations may be made up to six months in advance of arrival for select sites.
3. The NRRS charges non-refundable fees beyond our camping fees for making reservations, reservation changes, late cancellations, and no-shows.
4. All Campground policies and procedures apply to reservable sites.
5. Check-in time for reserved sites is 4:30 p.m. on the date of arrival. Check-out time is 3:30 p.m. on departure date. Late departures are prohibited.

SEASONAL CAMPING

A limited number of campsites are available for seasonal camping, for two to nine months. For information, call LBL at 270-924-2044.

FOR YOUR SAFETY

1. Pets **MUST** be on a leash of 6 ft. or less and under physical control at all times.
2. For health and sanitation purposes, you are required to clean up after your pet.
3. Campers under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
4. Immediately report any theft, loss, accident, or disturbance to the staff or call 911.
5. Fireworks are prohibited at all times.
6. Firearms are prohibited, except during LBL hunting season by licensed and permitted hunters.
7. Archery target practice is permitted only in designated areas. Broadhead arrows are prohibited.
8. All campfires must be contained in designated fire rings.
9. Do not burn trash in fire rings (could spread outside ring).
Please extinguish all campfires thoroughly before vacating your site.
9. The designated swimming and beach area is open during daylight hours to campers only and availability is dependent on lake conditions.
10. Pets, alcoholic beverages, and glass containers are not permitted on the beach, in swimming areas, or in bathrooms or showers.
11. State law prohibits public consumption of alcoholic beverages.

WARNING: SWIMMING OR DIVING IS NOT ALLOWED AT THE OLD ROCK QUARRY SITE. EXTREMELY DANGEROUS CONDITIONS EXIST!!

RULES OF THE ROAD

1. The speed limit is 15 mph and is enforced throughout the campground. Please be courteous and cautious, driving slower in congested areas.
2. Golf carts may serve as an additional means of transportation for individuals displaying an official state-issued accessible window tag or license plate. Only the individual issued the tag is permitted to operate the golf cart, unless a physical impairment does not allow.
3. Motorcycles must be properly licensed and used on camp roads only.
4. All motorized vehicle operators must possess a valid driver's license. Safety helmets are required. Mopeds/Scooters are not permitted on walking or biking trails. All state and federal laws are enforced.
5. All-terrain vehicles (ATVs) are prohibited. They may not be unloaded in camping areas. Please visit Turkey Bay Off-Highway Vehicle (OHV) Area for riding.
6. Please observe "No Wake Zones" near swimming areas, boat launches, and courtesy docks.
7. After quiet hours, please limit vehicle traffic to entering and exiting the campground.

OUR ENVIRONMENT NEEDS YOUR HELP

LBL is working toward a cleaner, healthier environment.

1. Discharge of gray & black water is prohibited by law. Please use dump stations. Citations will be written.
2. Vehicle maintenance is prohibited within campground.
3. Do not clean fish or other game in bathrooms, showers, sinks, or water faucet/hydrants.
4. Do not wash dishes, brush teeth, or wash up at potable water sources.
5. For your safety, drinking water is treated and monitored by employees with state certifications.
6. To protect water supply from harmful bacteria, please do not leave water hoses attached to hydrants when not in use. Hoses must be removed from hydrant areas.
7. Wastewater is processed onsite through state permitted treatment facilities. Please help us maintain the quality of treatment by using biodegradable detergents and antifreezes. Remember, ultimately the treated water is discharged into the lake.
8. Do not nail or carve trees, or hang lanterns on them. It will damage and destroy our natural resources.
9. Wildlife and plants are protected. Please do not feed the wildlife.
10. During deer hunting season, field dressed deer can only be cleaned at Archery Range, not at campsite.
