REQUEST FOR COMMENTS  
USDA Forest Service  
Land Between The Lakes National Recreation Area  
Trigg County, Kentucky  
Crooked Creek Prescribed Fire

Pursuant to 36 CFR 215.5, the Area Supervisor, William P. Lisowsky, requests comments on a prescribed fire project. A Decision Memo for this project will be prepared in accordance with FSH 1909.15 Section 31.2, Category 6.

The project area is located on approximately 1,530 acres of the Crooked Creek watershed, south of FS Road 153, north of Hwy 68/80, east of The Trace, and west of FS Road 148 in the Oak-Grassland Restoration Demonstration Area. Prescribed burning is planned for the 2008 burn season and is integral to restoration of oak-grassland community structure.

Comments must be postmarked or received within 30 days following the date of publication of this legal notice in the Paducah Sun. Only those who submit timely comments, or other expression of interest, will have eligibility for appeal purposes. In order to have appeal eligibility, each individual or representative from each organization submitting comments must either sign the comments or verify identity upon request.
