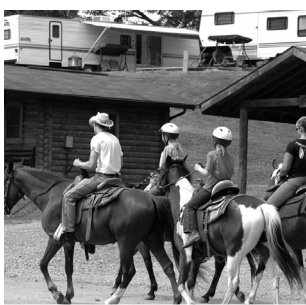

**No pets and no smoking in camping shelters.**

#### Shelters include:

INSIDE: One double bed & one bunk bed (Piney) and one double bed with either one or three bunk beds (Wranglers), ceiling fan with light, small table, folding chairs or benches, and electrical outlets.

OUTSIDE: Porch, fire ring, and picnic table. Restroom/shower buildings and outpost supply center are located in campground.
